

4 Reasons We Stand in Awe of God

Romans 11:29-36

- 1. The *grace* of God is *irrevocable*. (28-29)**
 - **God has not abolished His covenant with His chosen people Israel.**
 - **God's faithfulness to Israel assures us that He will not revoke His salvation from those who are sealed by His Spirit.**
- 2. The *mercy* of God is *indescribable*. (30-32)**
 - **What an amazing God we serve, that even through Israel's disobedience He is still lavishing mercy upon them.**
 - **"Oh give thanks to the Lord for He is good, for His mercy endures forever" (Ps. 136:1).**
- 3. The *mind* of God is *unsearchable*. (33-35)**
 - **So often we're tempted to ask "Why did God do that...why would He allow that to happen?"**
 - **When we don't understand what God is doing, we can simply place our hand in His hand and trust that everything is going to be OK.**
 - **We may not know what He is doing, but He knows exactly what He is doing and that He intends to "work all things together for good to them who love Him and are the called according to His purpose" (Rom. 8:28).**
- 4. The *glory* of God is *inexhaustible*. (36)**
 - **As Paul completes the deep theological section of His letter to the Romans, He concludes with the most important point - it's all about GOD!**
