

The Path to Perfect Peace

Isa. 26:3-4

- 1. Perfect peace begins with a *trusting heart*. - “because he trusts in You” (v. 3b)**
 - a. Thank God we’ve got a Savior who can be trusted!**
 - b. Our God knows everything, sees everything, and has the power to do the impossible!**
 - c. All we must do is place our hand in the hand of our Heavenly Father (Matt. 6:33).**
- 2. Perfect peace results in a *focused mind*. - “whose mind is stayed on You” (v. 3a)**
 - a. Sounds biblical, doesn’t it? “Looking unto Jesus” (Heb. 12:2)**
 - b. I once heard a preacher say, “Let your glance be on your problems, but let you gaze be upon God.” That’s good advice!**
 - c. If our minds are fixed on God, though the storms of life rage about us we’ll be able to follow in the footsteps of our Savior. We’ll find the peace we’re searching for.**
